The Exodus Exodus 2:11-14:31



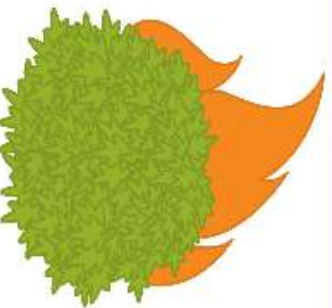
Moses asked Pharaoh to let the Hebrews go to the desert to worship God.

One day God spoke to Moses from a burning bush and told him to go back to Egypt to lead God's people from Egypt.



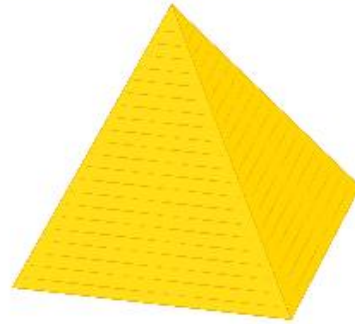
Moses prayed and God parted the waters so that the Hebrews could walk across the sea.



Pharaoh told Moses "No" 10 times. Each time he said no something bad happened.

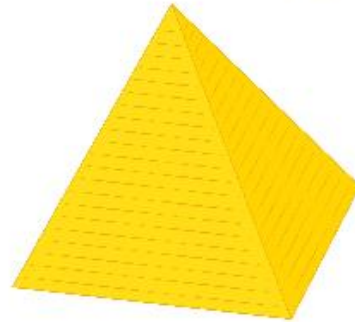


Pharaoh changed his mind and chased the Hebrews with his army until he trapped them by the sea.



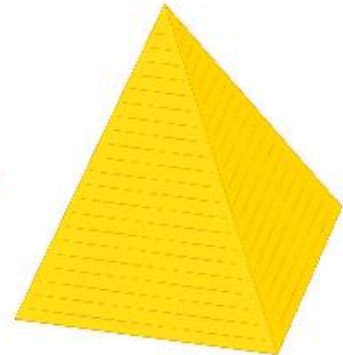
Snipping Practice

Practice beginning scissors skills by snipping along the lines from the edge.



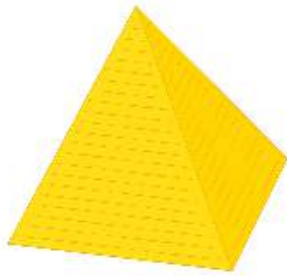
